





GROWTH: STORAGE

- Incoming projects will require exponential growth in storage capacity
 - books from Internet Archive
 - newspapers
 - audiovisual content
- Managing storage at this level adds cost, workload
 - increased staffing needs
 - reduced capacity for new development





UPDATES: NEWSPAPERS GRANT





- Rails plugin to support newspaper content within Samvera framework
- Support batch ingest workflows: issue, page, and article-level objects
- Feature parity with Chronicling America and other systems

UPDATES: MODS TO RDF RECOMMENDATIONS

v.1.0 released

- Samvera Metadata Interest Group
- 3-year collaborative effort
- 15+ libraries
- Provides RDF mapping for MODS XML descriptive metadata elements
- Facilitate sharing metadata in Linked Data context

The Repository Committee provides digitization, metadata, and technology expertise for Digital Commonwealth


- Liaison between BPL development team and DC board




FEATURES: DC 3.0

- Reduce schema dependencies
 - database modeling
 - generate serializations on demand
- More scalable
 - storage should be easily added
 - load balancing, replication, sharding
- API first
 - ability to swap out components as needed
- Microservices model
 - many pieces with fewer responsibilities






USAGE: SESSIONS PER DAY



USAGE: ITEM VIEWS




USAGE: PAGES PER SESSION












Brockton: The Early Years as a City in Photographs, 1881-1950










An eating place of international fame. The Brass Rail, 7th Avenue






Section of tank after Molasses Disaster explosion. 1:00pm




Fire House no. 31 damaged, Molasses Disaster. 1:00pm


